

Individual Card - Information Sheet

1. The Individual Card is a substitutive self-declaration of generalities, and is currently issued in the official languages of Italian and Slovenian (Peace Treaty, Annex VI, Art.7), in addition to English (for international use). However, in the future Croatian could be included as an official language of the Free Territory of Trieste.
2. The Individual Card can be requested by all citizens residing in the Free Territory of Trieste (regardless of their citizenship), and by citizens of the Free Territory of Trieste also residing abroad.
3. The Individual Card has been authorized and approved since January 2024 by the United Nations Security Council and by the United Nations Secretary General.
4. In case local or foreign authorities ask for clarification, they can contact directly the United Nations Security Council, in its role of authorizing body of the Individual Card (pending the appointment of the Governor).
5. The Individual Card was sent to all members of the United Nations in order to inform their authorities in their respective states.
6. At the time of issuing the Individual Card, the holder declares his citizenship as corresponding to the truth, on the basis of his good faith and based on the information in his possession at the time of issue of the Individual Card.
7. The holder is aware of future and possible checks that could be carried out by competent authorities in order to verify the citizenship. In the event of information that differs from what was declared by the applicant, the card will be cancelled, and it will be possible for the holder to request a new one with updated details.
8. Those who wish to verify that they have citizenship of the Free Territory of Trieste can contact the bodies currently managing the registry services.
9. In case of a request to show a document, the holder can show the identification card under his/her own responsibility, and kindly provide the information from points one (1) to four (4), or opt to show a different identification card.
10. The QRCode on the Individual Card can be scanned in order to verify the validity of the card itself.
